



Master of Education and Theology



In 2024 units will be available online or face-to-face.

The Master of Education and Theology is a coursework Master's degree that offers teachers an opportunity to complement and extend their previous learning in education and religious education. The course consists of a combination of required and elective units, with a high degree of flexibility in the choice of units. The course duration is three semesters of full-time study or equivalent part-time study (credit available for relevant postgraduate studies).

Accreditation and Sponsorship

This course is a recognised course for teacher accreditation and sponsored study in all Victorian dioceses. In other dioceses, teachers should check with their education office.

Course structure

9 units (24 points each) comprised of:

- DR9663Y Leadership for Mission in a Catholic School
- 24 points in Biblical Studies or Systematic Theology
- 24 points in Education or Religious Education or Systematic Theology
- Either a Capstone Unit or RQ9748M Minor Thesis
- Further units at postgraduate level (provided that at least 96 points of postgraduate elective units are included)

Entry requirements

- An undergraduate degree, and
- a qualification recognised for teacher accreditation in Australia, and
- two years of full-time teaching experience or part-time equivalent.
