






Master of Education and Theology

The Master of Education and Theology

(MEdTheol) is a coursework Master's degree that offers teachers an opportunity to complement and extend their previous learning in education and religious education. The course consists of required and elective units. The course duration is three semesters of full-time study or equivalent part-time study (credit available for relevant postgraduate studies).

Entry requirements

- · An undergraduate degree, and
- a qualification recognised for teacher accreditation in Australia, and
- two years of full-time teaching experience or part-time equivalent.

- · 24 points in Biblical Studies or Systematic Theology
- 24 points in Education or Religious Education or Systematic Theology
- Either the capstone unit or the Minor Thesis
