The **Master of Education and Theology** (MEdTheol) is a coursework degree that offers teachers an opportunity to complement and extend their previous learning in education and religious education. The course duration is three semesters of full-time study or equivalent part-time study.

Credit is available for relevant postgraduate studies.

Entry requirements

- An undergraduate degree
- a qualification recognised for teacher accreditation in Australia
- two years of full-time teaching experience or part-time equivalent
