### CALL FOR SUBMISSION: ANNUAL ESSAY PRIZES

CTC offers annual prizes of \$500 for outstanding essays in a range of subject areas. These prizes are awarded for essays submitted for assessment for CTC units at any time during 2025.

#### To be eligible:

- Every essay considered must have been submitted in 2025 for assessment in a CTC unit above level 1 and have met the requirements for Academic Integrity.
- Every essay considered must be at least 1,500 words in length.
- Essays must be submitted by the **due date, Friday 30 January 2026, COB 5pm**.

#### To enter:

- Essays must be **submitted to the Registrar in Word or PDF format** together with a 50-100 word abstract and discipline area for which it is submitted.
- Submissions must include the following information:
  - o Year and semester it was submitted for assessment
  - o Unit code and name
  - o Approximate word count
- No essay may be submitted for consideration in more than one discipline area.

#### Other Criteria:

- Prizes are only awarded if an essay of sufficient merit is submitted.
- No essay can win more than one prize.
- Minor Theses are not eligible for academic essay prizes, as there is a separate prize for them.

Prize-winning essays will be announced at the CTC College Mass in June 2026.


## 2026 GRADUATIONS

Once you've met the requirements for your course of study, CTC will apply to the University's Academic Board for you to graduate.

Formal confirmation of eligibility to graduate must be made by the University's Academic Board. As soon as this has occurred, eligible students for each ceremony will be sent an email from the Dean of Academic Programs at the Office of the Vice-Chancellor, inviting you to register online for a ceremony. You should complete the registration process whether you intend to attend a ceremony or not.
