One of the most effective ways to secure your information from your online account against unauthorised access. Learn more: [MFA](#).

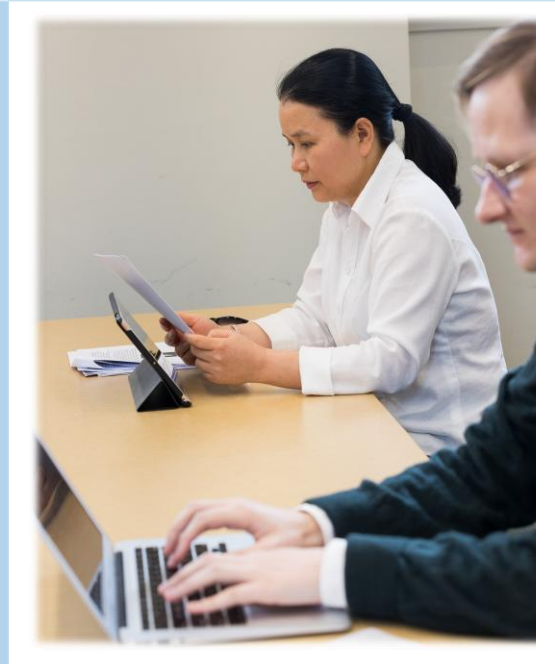
2. Passphrases
