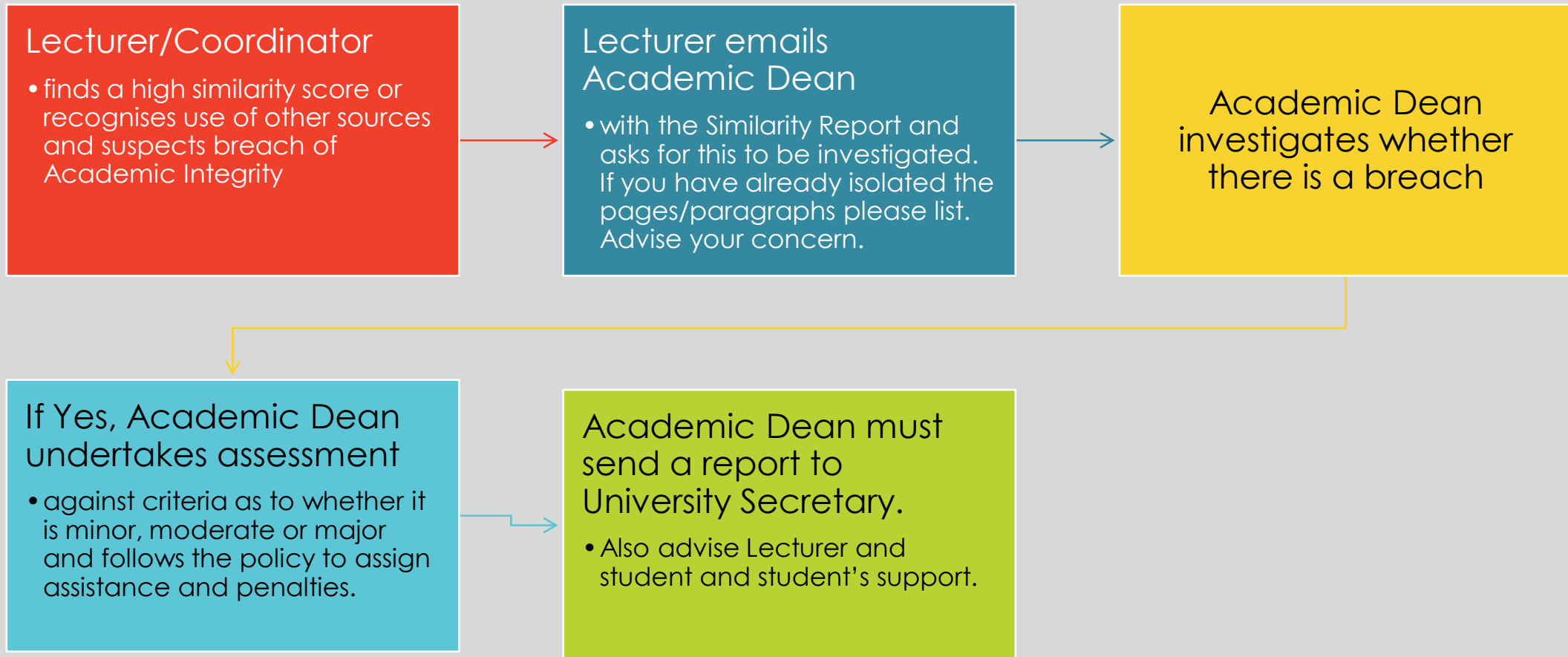

Type	Actions and Penalties	Authorised Officer
Minor	<p>One or more of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Issue and record a written warning regarding the consequences of breaching University policy• Counsel the student and refer the student to services such as study skills support or to the library for assistance• If appropriate, adjust the student's mark in the relevant assessment task to take account only of work which is in line with principles of academic integrity• Undertake an alternative action appropriate to the circumstances, consistent with penalties permitted under Regulation 82.
